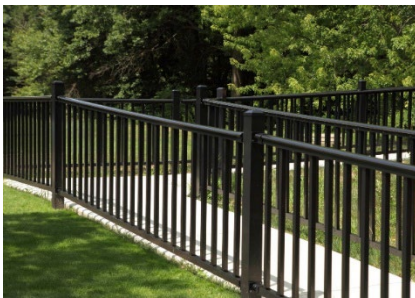


Demand Grows!

Common Fence Install Errors

Faulty installation can lead to a range of problems, including loose sections, uneven fence lines, and gate misalignment. It's crucial to ensure your aluminum fence is installed correctly to avoid these issues. Two of the biggest issues would be as follows.

Post hole depth - Holes for fence posts should be at least 24 inches deep and 6–8 inches in diameter. In areas that experience freezing, posts should be below the frost line, and the bottom of the hole should be widened to prevent heaving.

Drainage - Poor drainage can cause water to accumulate, which can lead to discoloration and damage to the foundation. This can be especially problematic in areas that experience heavy rainfall, flooding or snowmelt.

Maintenance and Care

To clean an aluminum fence, mix mild soap with warm water. Use a soft cloth or sponge to apply the soapy solution, gently scrubbing away dirt and grime. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue. For tougher stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner and a soft brush. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the finish. Dry with a clean cloth to prevent water spots. Regular cleaning helps maintain the fence's appearance and longevity.

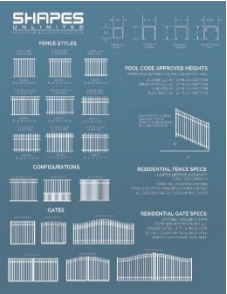
